### **Purpose**

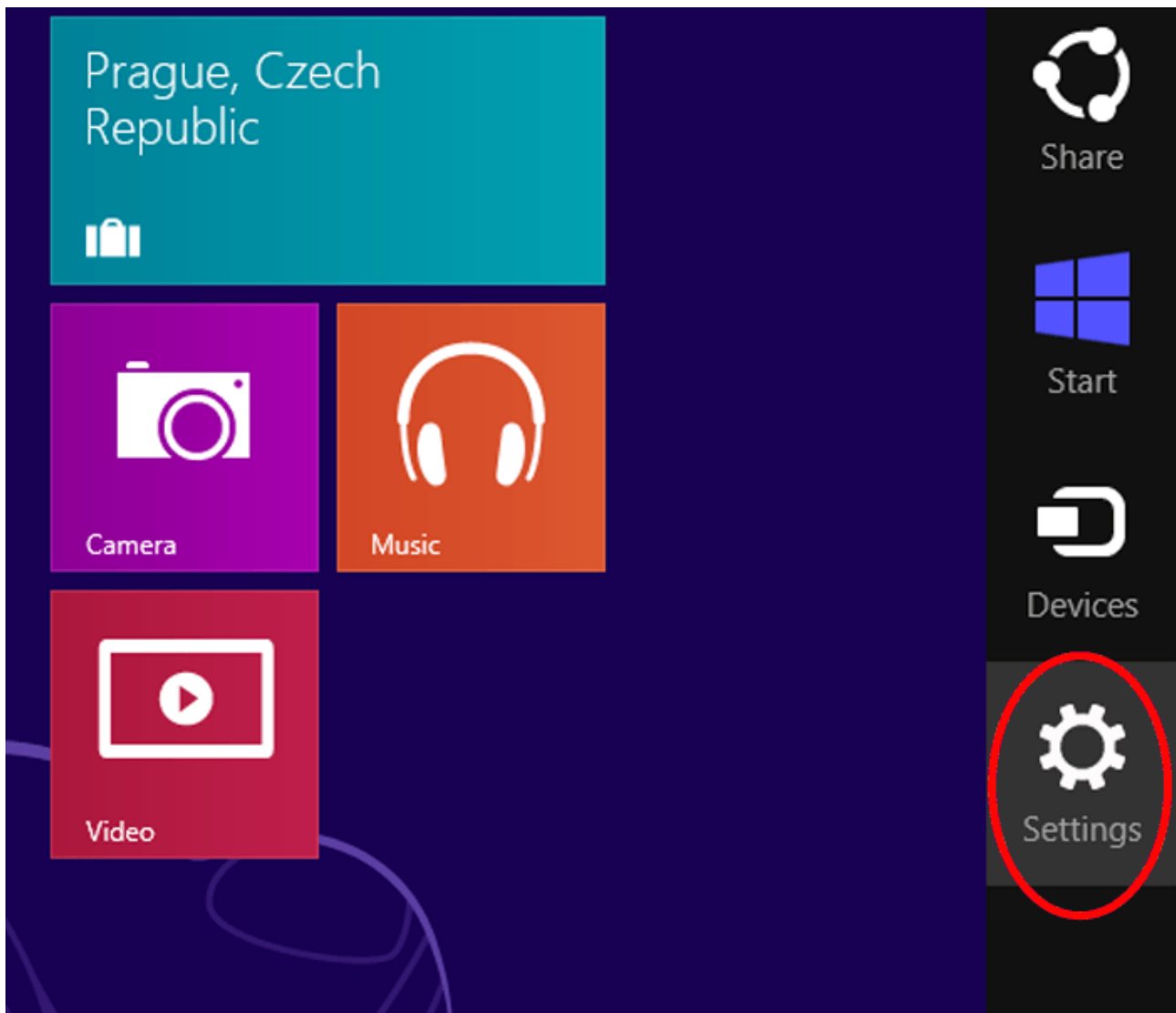
The document is aimed to illustrate the procedure for disable driver signature enforcement in Windows 8.1 in order to install scanner driver.

### **Scope**

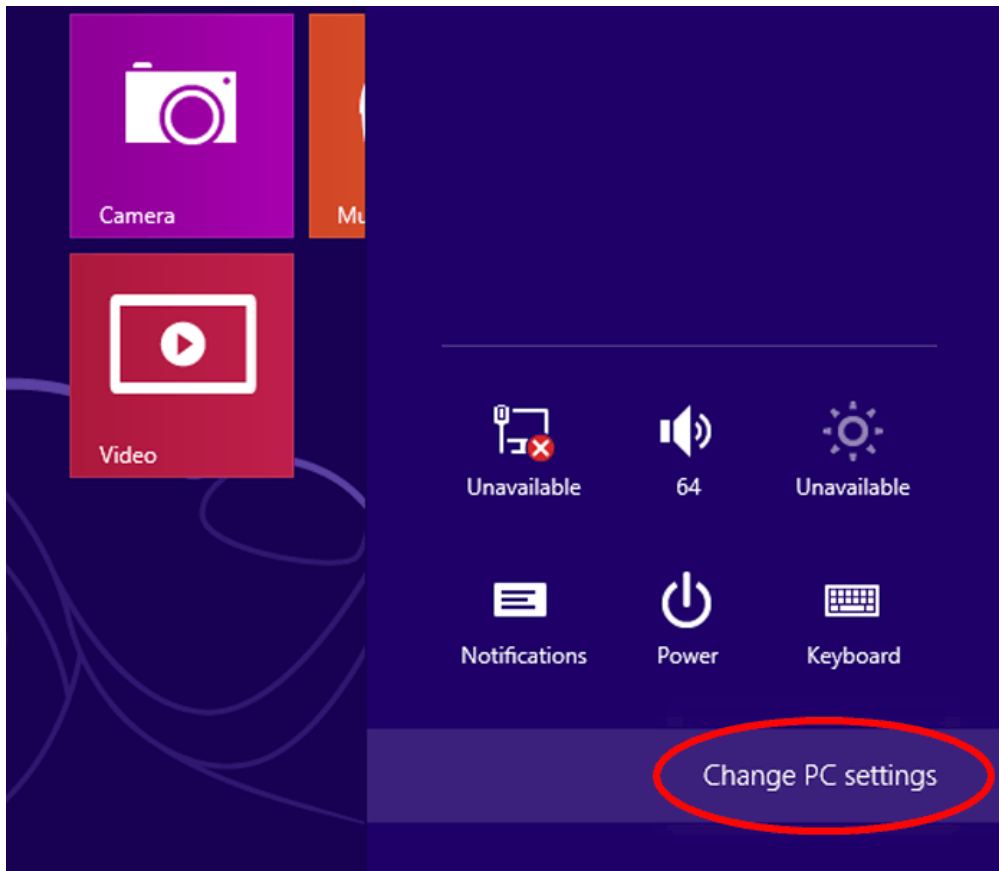
This document is applicable to Windows 8.1.

### **Procedure**

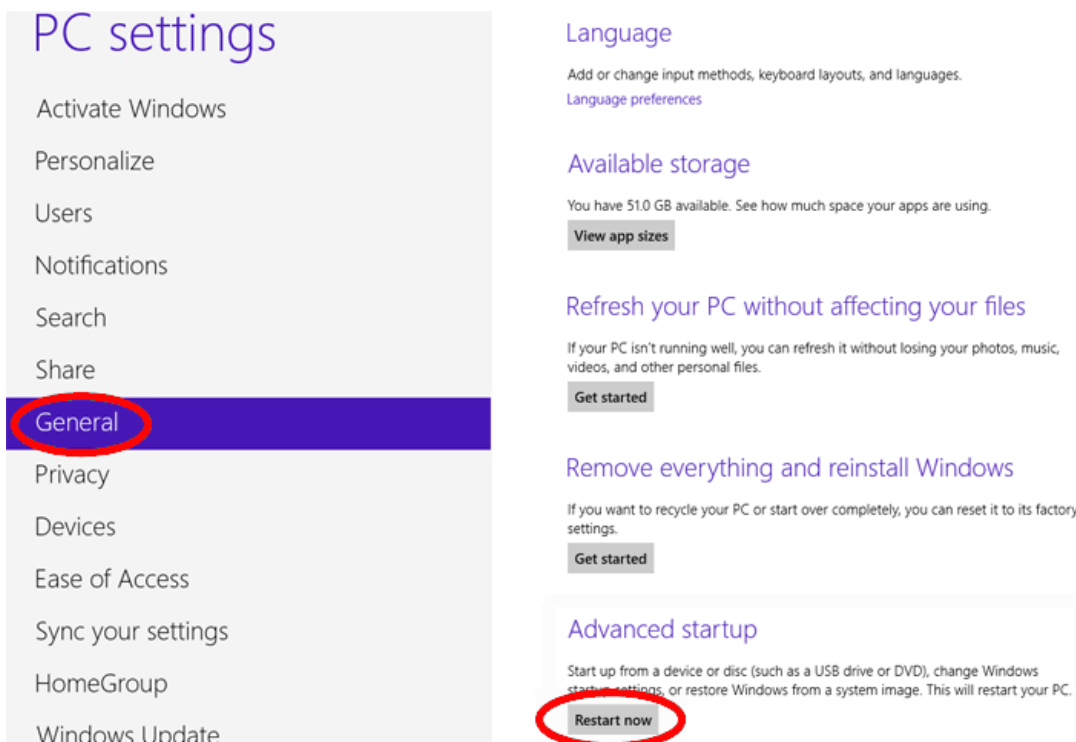
-Open "Charms Menu" by simultaneously pressing WIN key (also referred to Windows logo key) and C key, and select "Settings".



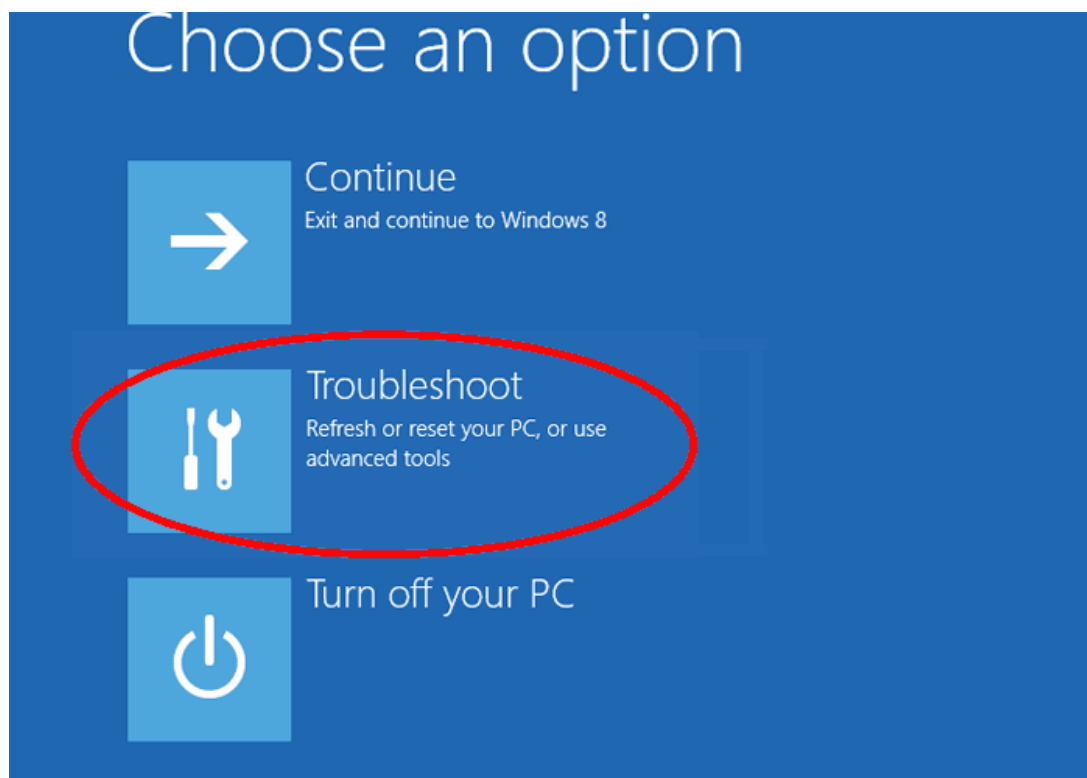
-Click "Change PC settings" on the bottom.



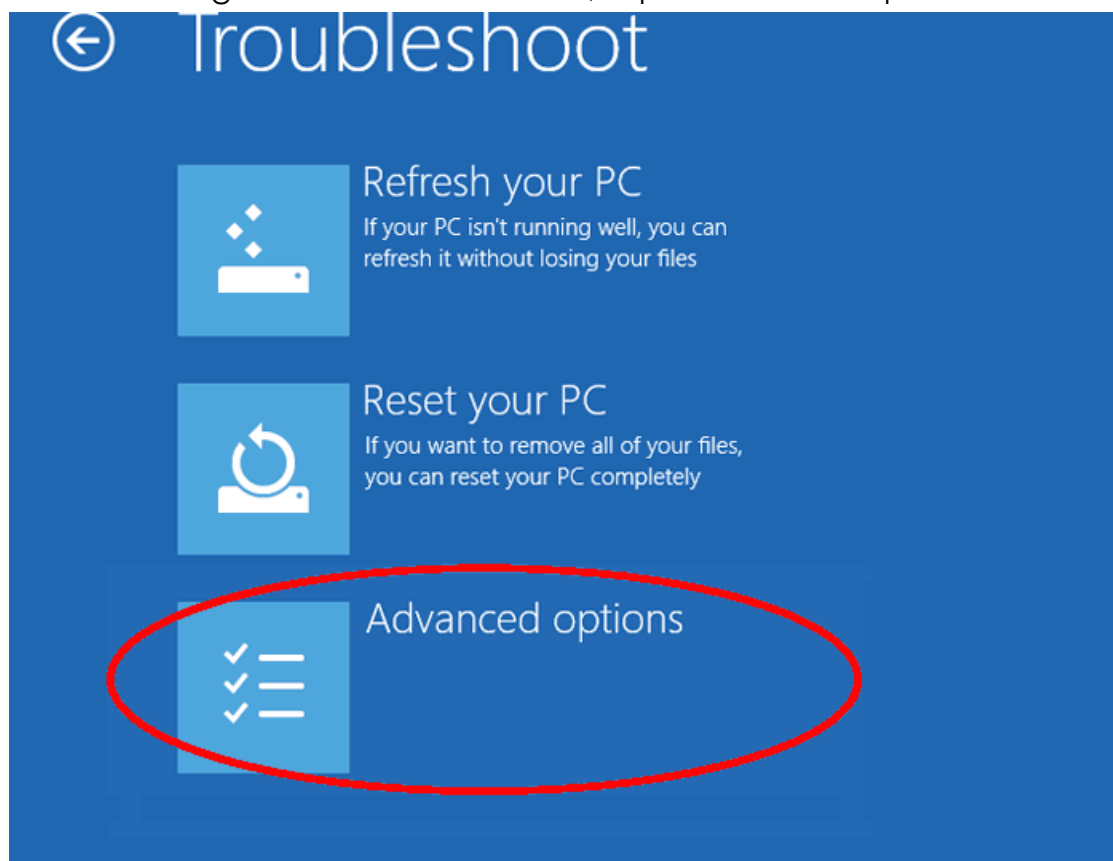
-In PC settings, choose "General" on the left and scroll down the screen on the right to click "Restart now" under Advanced startup, as shown below.



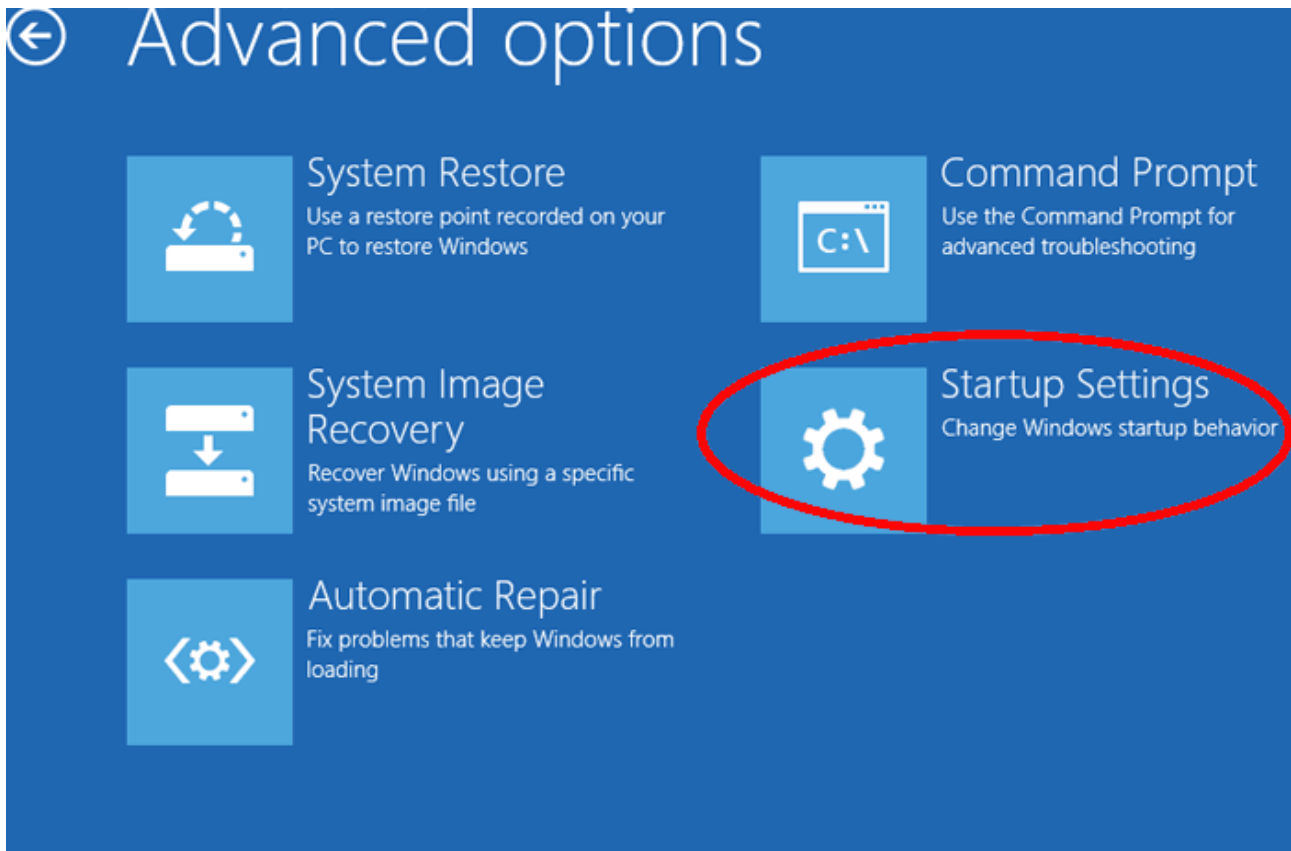
-Click "Troubleshoot" in the next interface.



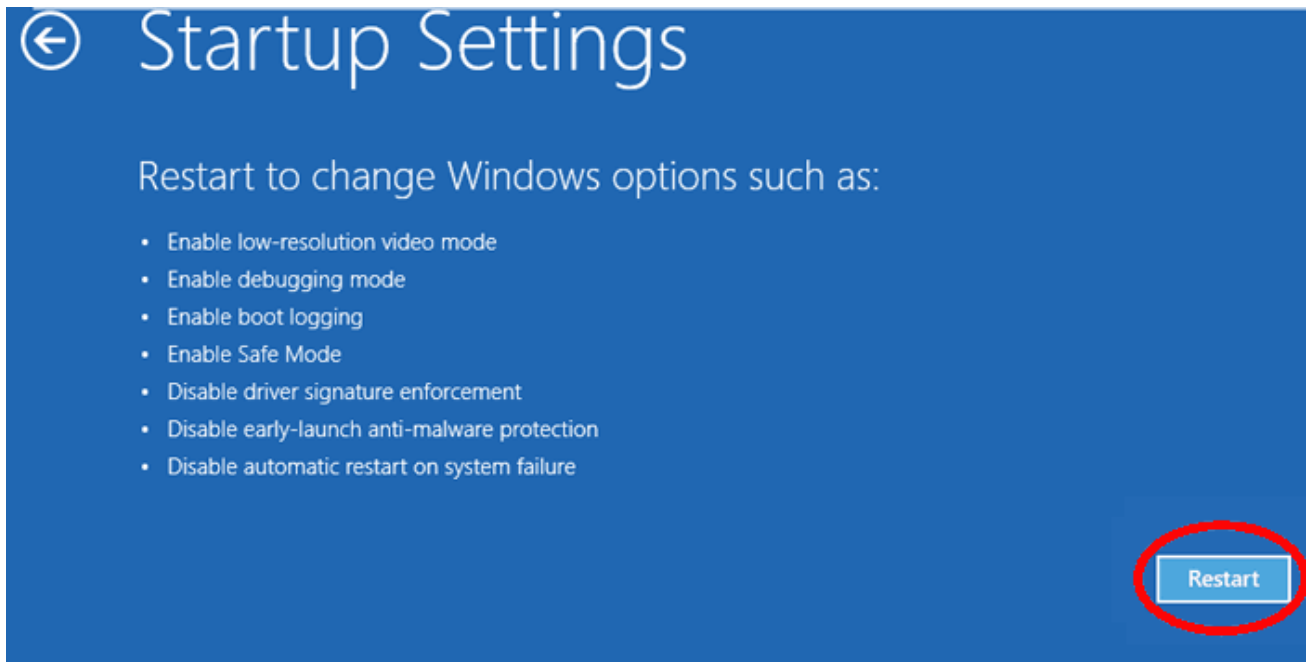
-After entering Troubleshoot interface, tap "Advanced options" to enter it.



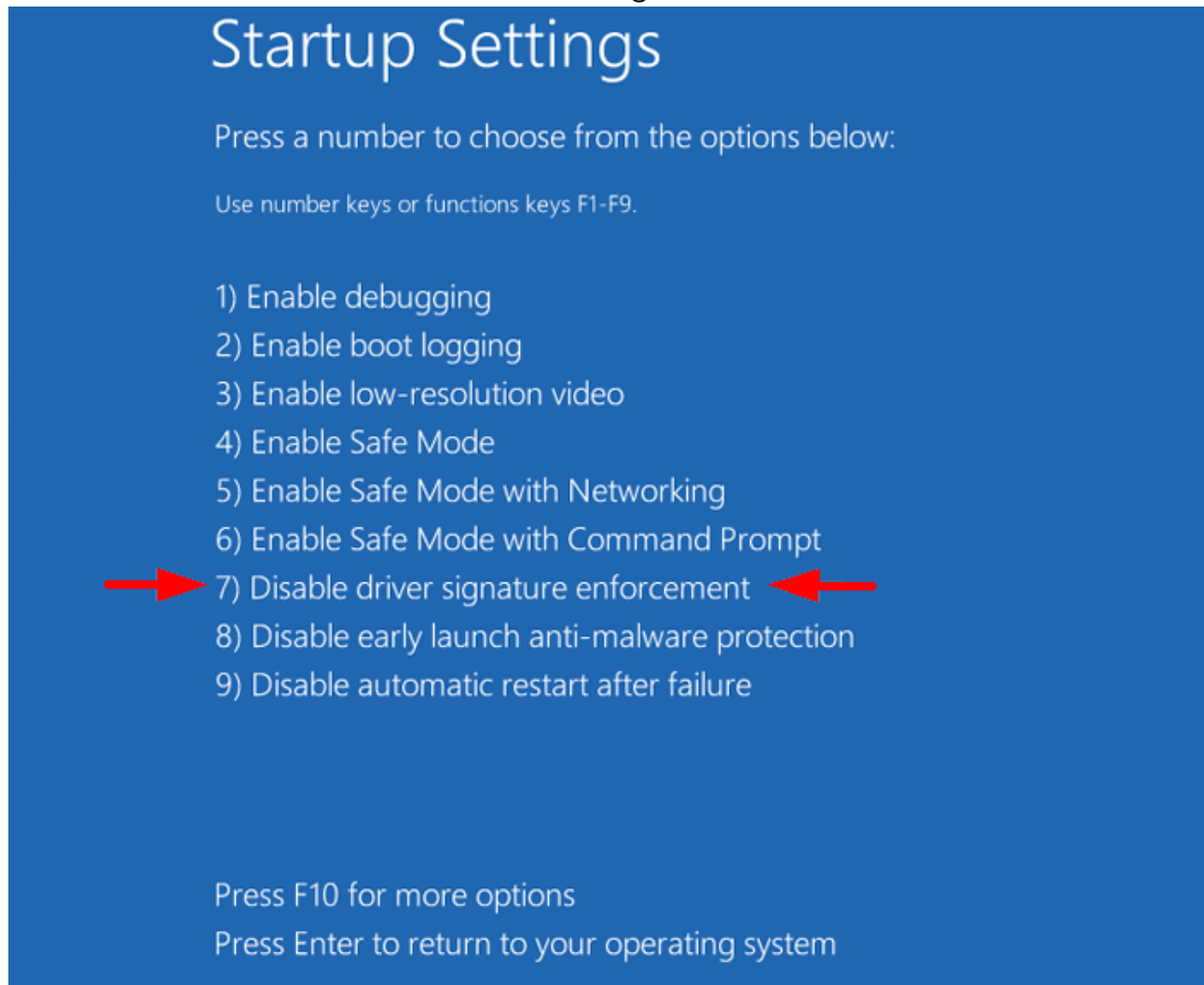
-Select "Startup Settings". Please refer to the picture below.



-Click "Restart" button in Startup Settings interface.



-Press "7" or "F7" to choose Disable driver signature enforcement.



-Finally the driver signature enforcement is disabled. Then start to install scanner driver.
